**Date:** Friday 5<sup>th</sup> of March

**Venue:** Joe Carmody Athletics Track Newborough. **Please note that for this school event, students are required to be picked up and dropped off at the Joe Carmody Athletics Track in Newborough.** Students do not attend school on this day. Parents need to have their children at the track at 8.50am, where the children assemble in the school area. Teachers then mark attendance rolls before the day begins. Please arrive to collect your child/ren at 2:15pm. The school bus **does not** run on this day. After School Care also does not run on this day.

**What to Bring:** Children need to wear their school uniform suitable for sports activities including school hat and runners. Please dress appropriately for the weather conditions. Students will also need a substantial lunch, snacks, water and sunscreen.
